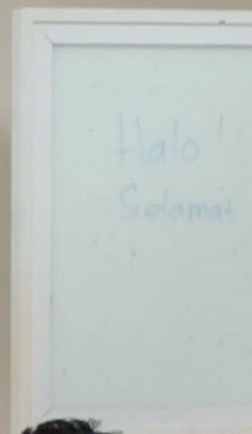

# Our Curriculum



## BIPA 1

- 3-hour classes daily on weekdays
- Learn basic Indonesian listening, speaking, reading, writing, and grammar
- Best for students who want to learn beginner-level Indonesian on a daily basis with a personalized approach



## BIPA 2

- 3-hour classes daily on weekdays
- Learn more advanced Indonesian vocabulary and usage beyond BIPA 1
- Best for students who want to learn intermediate-level Indonesian on a daily basis with a personalized approach



## Basic Indonesian Grammar & Conversation (BIGC) 1&2

- 3–4 hours of classes per week (2 weekdays)
- Learn basic Indonesian grammar, conversation, and culture
- Best for students who cannot attend daily BIPA classes



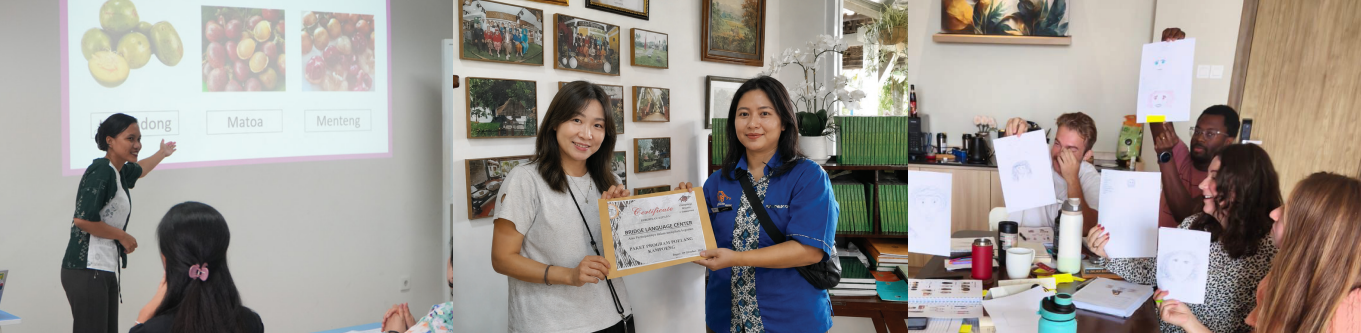
## Daily Indonesian Conversation (DIC)

- Classes twice a week on weekdays (June–July)
- Practice and deepen Indonesian conversation skills
- Best for learners with BIPA 1 or equivalent level who want a personalized approach



## Private Tutoring (PT)

- Small, personalized classes tailored to each student
- Instructors visit students' locations for customized lessons
- Best for students seeking to improve Indonesian through personalized learning

- BIGC and DIC sessions are conducted twice a week, following the academic calendar for each term.
- The DIC course, typically available in June and July, may also be offered during regular semesters as needed.
